We especially encourage your participation in the Centennial Memorial Walkway project in our 75 year-old heritage designated Memorial Park. Your early participation is encouraged so that the project can be completed in time for the 2012 celebrations.

“Quansum Elip” the motto on our 1912 corporate seal challenges us “to be always in front.” We remember this motto as we celebrate. You can help create a path of lasting memories that will cherish and honour our past, celebrate today, and provide a story for tomorrow.

Pay tribute to those you hold dear in your family and in your community by participating in the Memorial Walkway Project. Create a lasting legacy with your personal dedication on a paving stone to be set into the walkway at Memorial Park. Individuals, businesses and organizations are invited to participate in the project and leave a special message for tomorrow. Your paving stone could honour:

- a departed loved one,
- your family,
- a special friend
- a community pioneer
- a current or historic business, or
- a community organization or sports team.

You can reserve your paver for the walkway by completing an application form. Application forms are available at Municipal Hall, 1229 Esquimalt Road and the Recreation Centre, 527 Fraser Street. You can also download the application form at www.esquimalt.ca.

- One hundred dollars (\$100) will reserve a 4”x8” small brick with 3 lines of 18 characters per line.
- Two hundred dollars (\$200) will reserve a large 8”x8”brick with 4 lines of 18 characters per line.

A draw for a free standard (small) brick for each 100 bricks reserved will be made from those participating. A tax deductible receipt will be issued for the full amount of the brick.

All funds raised will go towards the celebration of Esquimalt's centennial and centennial projects. After the celebrations end, come often and take a walk down the Centennial Walkway to relive and enjoy the memories that you helped create.
